

Membership Types

■ Active

Pharmacists licensed or registered with a pharmacy regulatory body in Canada or persons with a professional degree in pharmacy. Only Active members hold the right to vote on Society issues.

■ Active Honorary Life/Honorary Life

Individuals recognized for career contributions to hospital pharmacy (peer nomination). No fee applicable.

■ Active-In-Training (postgraduate)

Persons who are enrolled in full or part-time postgraduate programs including residents, PharmD students, and persons doing fellowships. **Proof of enrollment is required** to secure this rate (e.g., copy of student card, letter of acceptance, or current transcript).

■ Hospital Corporate

Hospitals and regional health systems that support the objectives of and pay fees to the Society.

■ Industry Corporate

Pharmaceutical companies that support the objectives of and pay fees to the Society. This membership entitles one company representative to the same benefits as a supporting member.

■ Joint

Two Active members residing at the same residential address. Only one person receives the regular membership mailings, although both are members. Each member pays the joint member fee (refer to fee schedule for details).

■ Retired

Retired members pay half of the total fee for Active/Supporting. On the application form, please indicate your date of retirement.

■ Student (undergraduate)

Persons enrolled in an undergraduate pharmacy program. **Photocopy of student card is required** to secure the student rate.

■ Supporting

Persons who support the objectives of and pay fees to the Society but are not eligible for other membership categories.

Fee Discount Eligibility

Are you eligible for a membership discount?

New Active/Supporting Member Discount Program

This discount applies to members who are purchasing an Active or Supporting level membership for the first time. This includes new members as well as renewing members who have only ever held a Student or Active-In-Training level membership. If you are purchasing a Joint level membership for the first time, you may also qualify for this discount. Please note this is not a two year membership but rather, a discount program that spans two consecutive membership years. For example, in the first year of membership, you will save 50% of your membership fee. In the second consecutive year of membership, you will save 25% of your membership fee.

This discount does not apply to the Student, Active-In-Training, Retired or Leave of Absence categories.

Leave of Absence (LOA)

Are you an Active member on sabbatical, illness or maternity/parental leave? If so, this category was designed for you. Members in this category will receive full membership benefits during the year. Leave must be a minimum of 6 months in duration. If you are an Active member and unexpectedly leave the field in the middle of the year for a reason consistent with the LOA criteria, you may apply for a LOA membership during the next membership year. Members may take advantage of this category for only 3 membership years, consecutive or not, in their careers. On the application form, please indicate the type and expected duration of leave (e.g., maternity leave - February 1, 20xx to January 31, 20xx).

Did someone encourage you to join CSHP? Spread the word.

Our members are our most important resource so we want to reward them for spreading the word about CSHP. If someone encouraged you to join the Society, provide their name on the 'referring member' line of your application. 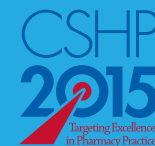

The CSHP 2015 is derived from the American Society of Health-System Pharmacists 2015 initiative but adapted to the Canadian healthcare environment based on input from key stakeholders.

CSHP 2015 is a quality initiative with 6 goals focusing on 4 specific areas:

- making medication use effective (2 goals, one related to care of hospitalized patients and the other to the care of non-hospitalized patients)
- making medication use scientific (i.e., evidence-based)
- making medication use safe (2 goals, one focusing on systems and one focusing on technology)
- making meaningful contributions to public health
