



ANN E. O'TOOLE NEW PRACTITIONER AWARD

This award is presented annually to a newly practicing hospital pharmacy practitioner to recognize their leadership or contribution to CSHP, or their high level of practice interest or commitment to their area of hospital pharmacy practice.

Candidate must:

1. Be an active member of CSHP.
2. Have practised in pharmacy for less than 5 years in a hospital setting.
3. Have demonstrated leadership or contribution by involvement in CSHP. Involvement shall consist of activities such as: serving on committees (either local or national); serving as an elected officer of CSHP; chairing or serving on task forces, special projects or commissions; giving presentations or authoring publications related to hospital pharmacy practice.

OR

Have demonstrated a high level of job interest or commitment in their area of hospital pharmacy practice.

4. Be nominated by two active members of the Nova Scotia Branch CSHP, who must submit a completed application form to the Awards Committee Chairperson.

Deadline for Applications:

All applications are to be submitted to the Chairperson of the Awards Committee on/before a date determined by CSHP Awards Committee.

Selection of Recipient:

Will be determined by Awards Committee and award will include an engraved pen. It will be presented at the Nova Scotia Branch CSHP Annual Awards Dinner.
